MAPPING - Mark Miller, Supervisor of Assessments, has given 911 the spring 2017 flights.

SALEM – Justin Draper and Bradford pulled wires at the Salem PD. Took a little over two days. Bradford will coordinate with H&H to pull Centralia's wires.

EATON – Bradford has requested that Greg Stearman from Eaton come access the 911 UPS situation and give the board a quote on a new configuration for both PSAPs.

GENERATOR: Centralia went through a power outage Saturday. The transfer switch on the generator did not kick over. The Centralia City electrician is looking into a possible upgrade to resolve this.

OLD BUSINESS:

CAD/RMS Access Policy – Bradford made changes clarifying that an outside agency must request all reports from the Coordinator or the Executive Board if the Coordinator is not available. A motion was made by Purcell to approve the policy and seconded by Brooks. Roll Call and Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

DISPATCH CHAIRS – Bradford requested to purchase three new chairs from AllPro Sales LLC for a cost of around \$1000 a chair. A motion was made by Gaston to approve the purchase and seconded by Squibb. Roll Call and Motion carried.
