For your consideration, and in addition to the Detailed Quote presented, in the Marion County ETSB Virtualization Project, is a new, required, service plan from Zetron called "Connected Care"(ZCC). Connected Care is like Zetron's Product Service Plan (PSP), with additional services and features; Zetron's Product Service Plan is being phased out. The numbers provided below also reflects GTSi's included labor for any on-site repairs or labor covered under ZCC. Please see the attached Zetron Connected Care brochure for more details.

With Zetron's Connected Care, you will have 24/7 Zetron remote support and a whole host of other features. In consulting with Zetron on the Virtualization Project, Connected Care is an integral, mandatory service upgrade in this project with a five (5) year agreement.

If Marion County ETSB approves the Virtualization Project, you will be refunded the unused balance of your current, Zetron Product Service Plan (PSP).

The first year of Zetron Connected Care for seven (7) PSAP positions would be \$36,415.06. Below is an annual breakdown of the cost for the five-year term with an annual four percent (4%) increase:

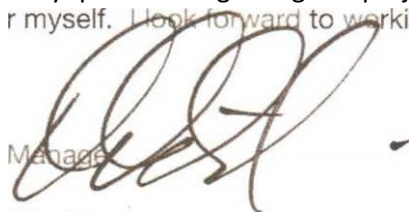

Year Four:	zcc: \$29,464.10	GTSi: \$20,247.55	Total: \$49,711.65
Year Five:	zcc: \$33,147.11	GTSi: \$21,057.45	Total: \$54,204.57

Report of Entrapment will require a Fire Department Response from all Agencies.

5-Minute Rule

It shall be the responsibility of the responding agency to notify dispatch within 5 minutes from the initial tone out, that they acknowledge the tone.

First Tone

5 Minutes Later— 2nd Tone re-tone responding agency and elevate to Full Still.

Note: Do not rush toning next department due to the fact some departments have store forwarding. Retoning too quickly can lock up the radios.

EXAMPLE:

INITIAL TONE: "Attention Fire, you are responding to a report of a single story dwelling structure fire at 123 Jones Ave. Cross street is 1st St. ***** Dispatch, at 1100 hrs."

5 Minutes later if you do not receive an acknowledgement by ***** Fire

2ND TONE: "Attention ***** Fire, second tone, you are responding to the report of a single story structure fire at 123 Jones Ave. Cross street is 1st St. ***** Dispatch, at 1104 hrs." Dispatch mutual aid from Full Still level. Note: If department has record playback (Iuka, Kinmundy, Patoka and Centralia Fire Protection District), skip 2nd tone.
